City Council Recap Highlights:

- The City Council authorized an employment contract with Kirk Pelser, to be appointed as Economic Development Director.
- City Council established a minimum savings threshold on outstanding CFD bonds in order to direct the City's Finance team to pursue refundings that would in-turn give homeowners a savings on their CFD tax.
- City Council approved a sponsorship payment of \$100,000 to the Cherry Festival Association to pay the balance of the entertainment costs.
- City Council approved the hosting of the 2025 Cherry Festival Parade, previously hosted by the Cherry Festival Association and the Rotary Club.
