A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCE CONTROL BOARD'S ADOPTED STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS, WATER QUALITY ORDER NO. 2006-003-DWO AND 2022-0103-DWO

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted Order No. 2006-0003-DWQ, Statewide General Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems, requiring owners of public sanitary sewer collection systems to prepare a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP); and

WHEREAS, the SSMP is a document with specific elements that addresses procedures to operate, maintain, and manage the collection system, requiring proper funding and management, with the goal to reduce the number and frequency of sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) and thereby decrease the risk to human health and the environment; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2022, the SWRCB adopted Order 2022-0103-DWQ, Statewide General Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems with an effective date of June 5, 2023, that allows a continuance of existing enrollees under Order 2006-0003-DWQ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council received a draft SSMP at a public City Council workshop held on February 28, 2023, at which time Fischer Compliance LLC gave a presentation for the purpose of receiving Council, staff, and public comments which have been incorporated into the final version being submitted herein to the City Council for further consideration; and

WHEREAS, the WDR requires the City's Legally Responsible Official (LRO) to certify in the State Sanitary Sewer database the adoption of the SSMP by the governing body;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BEAUMONT CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the SSMP attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The LRO is authorized to execute documents pertaining to the certification of the City's SSMP and to process the online SSO database form, including audits and compliance with the newly adopted order 2022-0103-DWQ.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
