SUBJECT: Declaration Of Surplus Property and Request for Donation of the Frisbee Golf Course to Beaumont Cherry Valley Parks And Recreation District

Description The surplus and donation of current frisbee golf equipment at Nicklaus Park.

Background and Analysis:

The Beaumont Municipal Code Chapter 3.03.010 states, in part, that the duties of staff include “the disposition of personal property in any lawful manner provided that the disposition is for the common benefit of the City's citizens. A formal declaration that the property is surplus shall not be required.”

The current Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) includes a project to create additional sports fields at Nicklaus Park. This improvement will require the repurposing of the current frisbee golf area located in the southeast corner of Nicklaus Park.

The frisbee golf metal nets and tee box areas are listed as surplus, and staff is requesting the schedule of their removal.

As part of this surplus process staff reached out to the Beaumont Cherry Valley Parks and Recreation District and proposed a donation of the frisbee golf course to be added to one of the district’s current park locations. The parks district has agreed to accept the donation and will coordinate with City staff to receive the donation.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated value of the donation is \$500 for the frisbee golf equipment. Staff estimates the cost to prepare this report to be \$250.

Recommended Action:

Approve the disposal and donation of identified City surplus property.
