SUBJECT: Adoption of a Resolution Authorizing Participation in the Community Development Block Grant Home Investment Partnership Program and Emergency Solutions Grant Program for Fiscal Years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27

Description Renewal of the cooperation agreement between the City of Beaumont and the County of Riverside for the Home Investment Partnership Program and Emergency Solutions Grant through Community Development Block Grant participation.

Background and Analysis:

The County of Riverside requires each city to periodically reaffirm its election to participate in the County's programs. This adoption of resolution and execution of the agreement allows the City continued participation in the County of Riverside Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program for Fiscal Years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27. Participation in these programs allows the City the opportunity to seek funding for eligible projects offered through the HOME and ESG programs.

Fiscal Impact:

The cost to prepare this staff report is approximately \$150.

Recommended Action:
