SUBJECT: Designation of Authorized Representatives for FEMA and Cal OES
Disaster Assistance

Description Approve resolution to designate authorized representatives for FEMA and Cal OES Disaster Assistance.

Background and Analysis:

The City applies for assistance from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and California's Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) when major disasters strike. FEMA administers federal disaster assistance programs, and Cal OES administers state disaster assistance programs. A designation of applicant's agent resolution for non-state agencies is required to be on file with Cal OES and updated every 3 years. The previous designation expired in September 2023.

By approving the attached resolution, the City Council designates the individuals who hold these specific positions to be the City's representatives to FEMA and Cal OES.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated cost to complete this report is \$65.
