SUBJECT: International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC) Annual Conference Attendance

Description Mayoral appointment of two Council Members to attend the International Council of Shopping Centers (ICSC) annual conference.

Background and Analysis:

Each year, Planning and Economic Development staff attend the ICSC annual conference in Las Vegas, Nevada. This is an opportunity for the City to market itself to local, state and nation wide retailers. The City partners with the County of Riverside for booth meeting space and display space providing a location for staff to meet with developers, provide demographic information, discuss development processes and current and future opportunities for development. Staff pre-arranges meetings with interested developers or retailers as well as conducts drop-in meetings throughout the event.

Previous attendance at this conference included the economic development and planning department staff. Many cities include attendance by City Managers, Council Members as well as department heads and department staff. This year ICSC is Sunday, May 19th – Tuesday, May 21st. Staff believes having City Council Member representation at this event would be a benefit to the City's retail and commercial recruiting efforts.

Fiscal Impact:

ICSC Registration \$1,050 per person, hotel averages \$250 per night per person and per diem \$172.50 per person. These costs have been included in the FY24 budget.
