SUBJECT: Declaration of Surplus Property

Description Approve the disposal and/or auction of surplus property.

Background and Analysis:

The Beaumont Municipal Code Chapter 3.03.010 specifically states, in part, that the duties of staff include the disposition of personal property in any lawful manner provided that the disposition is for the common benefit of the City's residents and that a formal declaration shall not be required.

Attached is a current list of equipment and items that have exhausted their lifespan and usefulness.

Disposal of surplus property will be made in the most economical and practical manner available, including, if required, the use of appropriate hazardous waste handlers.

Seven (7) buses on this list will be replaced pending delivery of new buses that have been ordered. Buses will be sent to auction once new buses have been received and old buses are decommissioned.

Fiscal Impact:

Funds received from auction of equipment and/or items will be deposited into their respective funds.

The estimated cost to prepare this report is \$150.
