- I. Preserve Local Control: Protect the City's autonomy
- II. Promote Fiscal Stability: Safeguard City revenue and oppose unfunded mandates.
- III. Support Funding Opportunities: Advocate for regional, state, and federal funding.
- IV. Enhance Public Safety; Reform laws impacting public safety and maintain emergency service authority
