Subject: Proposal to Extend Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Services in 2025 per the Maximum Benefits Monitoring Program Work Plan

Dear Mr. Van Belle:

Dudek entered into an agreement with the City of Beaumont (the City) on March 1, 2022 to provide groundwater and surface water monitoring services per monitoring requirements assigned to the City in the Maximum Benefits Monitoring Program work plan prepared for the San Timoteo and Beaumont Groundwater Management Zones. Dudek provided monitoring services in 2022, 2023, and 2024. The agreement automatically terminates after three years of service, unless it is extended by the parties with the approval of the City Council.

Dudek is proposing to extend our services for a fourth year in 2025 by following the original scope of work presented in our proposal to the City in 2022 (please see attached). Compensation in the agreement acknowledged a 3% increase to the budget year after year following the first year of service. The budget for providing the groundwater and surface water monitoring services in 2024 was \$55,550. The proposed budget for services provided in 2025 is \$57,165, or an increase by 3% of the 2024 budget.

FEE SUMMARY

The time and materials fee provided in this proposal represents an estimate of the anticipated level of effort required to complete the tasks described in the proposal. Should the actual effort required to complete the tasks be less than anticipated, the amount billed will be less than the total fee. Conversely, should the actual effort to complete the proposed tasks be greater than anticipated, additional fee authorizations will be requested. No work in excess of the proposed fee or outside of the proposed scope of work will be performed without written authorization from the City of Beaumont.


