	Transit Infrastructure Grants (TIG)	Transit projects under Chapter 53 of Title 49.	\$1M–\$5M	20%
	Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements (CRISI)	Rail grade separation projects.	\$1M–\$5M	20%
	Economic Development Initiative (EDI)	Affordable housing, parks, seismic retrofits, community centers, economic development.	\$1M–\$4M	None
<b>Homeland Security</b>	Emergency Operations Center (FEMA)	Emergency operations center construction and upgrades. <i>*Project would required CalOES letter of eligibility approval.</i>	\$1M–\$1.5M	25%
	Pre-disaster Mitigation (FEMA)	Flood resilience, stormwater, property buyouts in flood zones. <i>*Project would required CalOES letter of eligibility approval.</i>	\$1M–\$4M	25%
<b>Interior- Environment</b>	State and Tribal Assistance Grant (EPA)	Wastewater, stormwater, water treatment, and infrastructure.	\$1M–\$4M	20%
	Save America’s Treasures (NPS)	Historic preservation projects.	Up to \$500K	50%
<b>Energy and Water</b>	Corps of Engineers/Bureau of Reclamation	Water infrastructure, energy security, and resilience.	Varies	50–75%
<b>Commerce- Justice- Science</b>	COPS Technology and Equipment (DOJ)	Camera systems, radios, body cameras, and communication technology.	\$600K–\$3M	None
	Byrne Justice Assistance Grants (DOJ)	Crime prevention, substance abuse, community policing.	\$600K–\$1M	None
<b>Financial Services</b>	Small Business Initiative (SBA)	Entrepreneur training, workforce development, research, facility acquisition.	\$500K–\$1.5M	None
<b>Labor-HHS- Education</b>	Training and Employment Services (DOL)	Workforce and adult education programs under WIOA.	\$250K–\$1M	10%
