**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing and Consideration of a Resolution for the Fifth Amendment

to the City's Fiscal Year 2025-2029 Capital Improvement Plan

**Description** Approval of Resolution to amend the five-year FY 2025-2029 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

#### **Background and Analysis:**

The City's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is a 5-year planning document which identifies the major capital improvement expenditures and gives a proposed sequence of implementing their design and construction. The CIP is reviewed, revised, and adopted annually to account for completed and newly identified projects. Occasionally, the CIP is amended within a given year to promote better use of the City's limited financial resources, focus priorities, update projects, and assist in the coordination of public and private development.

On June 4, 2024, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2024-15 "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Beaumont Adopting a Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Years 2025-2029." Government Code Section 66022 allows the City Council to periodically update the adopted CIP.

On August 20, 2024, City Council approved the first amendment to the five-year Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal years 2025-2029.

On October 15, 2024, City Council approved the second amendment to the five-year Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal years 2025-2029.

On February 4, 2025, City Council approved the third amendment to the five-year Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal years 2025-2029.

On March 4, 2025, City Council approved the fourth amendment to the five-year Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal years 2025-2029.

Staff is proposing to amend the CIP further by revising three project budgets and closing ten CIP projects.

#### **BUDGET CHANGES**

**R25-06 Cougar & Beaumont Ave Traffic Signal Upgrade:** City staff is requesting to close out project R25-03 Citywide Traffic Signal Upgrades and to transfer funds to R25-06 Cougar & Beaumont Ave Traffic Signal Upgrade. The request is to fully fund the construction phase of the Cougar & Beaumont TS upgrade, including smart technology components.

**R-36 Citywide Street Rehabilitation FY 24:** City staff is requesting to transfer \$350,000 in funds to R25-01. R-36 is almost complete and has additional funds not being utilized. The transfer of funds would allow R25-01 a larger construction budget to include retrofitting additional ADA ramps.
