SUBJECT: Quarterly Grants Report FY2024-2025 Q4

Description Quarterly Grants Reporting from April 1, 2025, through June 30, 2025.

Background and Analysis:

The City of Beaumont is committed to fostering community development and growth through various initiatives and programs, including grant funding. As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance transparency and accountability, we identified the need to establish a comprehensive system for monitoring and reporting on the status of grants received and applied for by the city. The attached report outlines the status of all active and pending grants and provides an overview of our progress in centralizing the City of Beaumont's grant processes and record-keeping. During this process, as we continue to reconcile grant records from previous fiscal years, some minor corrections have been made to ensure the accuracy and consistency of reported information. This initiative aims to ensure that all grant-related activities are efficiently managed and accurately documented, supporting our commitment to community development and responsible financial stewardship.

Notable events this quarter include the California Transportation Commission's adoption of \$50.4 million in project funding for the Pennsylvania Grade Separation. The funding will be formally awarded upon completion of post-selection requirements and execution of the grant agreement.

Additionally, Congressman Ruiz has recommended \$3 million in federal appropriations funding for the Pennsylvania Grade Separation. This is currently pending approval by the Appropriations Committee and adoption of the federal budget.

In June, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved a \$4.1 million increase to the City's grant award from Riverside County Flood Control for the Master Drainage Plan Line 1 Stage 2 project. The increase, which is pending execution of a formal agreement, will be considered awarded once the agreement is finalized. This funding will allow the City of Beaumont to scale the project in preparation for the Pennsylvania

Grade Separation. This is a collaborative, forward-thinking approach to strengthening and expanding our infrastructure.
