NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City Council of the City of Beaumont will conduct a public hearing to consider the matter described below. The City Council's public hearing will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 15, 2025, at 550 East Sixth Street, Beaumont, California.

ADOPT A CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND MITIGATION AND MONITORING REPORT PROGRAM (MMRP) FOR THE CHERRY CHANNEL DRAINAGE (R-07). Conduct a public hearing to consider a request for adoption of a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation and Monitoring Reporting Program for the Cherry Channel Drainage. The proposed Project would remove the existing geo-mat lining, wingwall, and riprap within the channel and replace them with concrete along the slopes and channel bottom. The existing headwalls and culverts will remain in place and be protected. The proposed Project would result in reduced maintenance costs and improved flow of runoff to the channel. The Project site is located along Cherry Avenue between Cougar Way and Oak Valley Parkway within the Sundance Specific Plan on Assessor Parcel Numbers (APN) 408-250-034, 408-240-038, 408-090-066, 408-100-025 & 408-100-024.
