

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PAINT CURB COLORS FOR PARKING ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Beaumont seeks to promote public safety and ensure consistency in traffic and parking enforcement throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beaumont finds that it is in the public interest to grant the City Engineer the authority to evaluate, designate, and paint curb colors to identify restricted parking zones, such as no-parking (red), loading zones (yellow), and passenger loading (white), and other safety or operational areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously held a public discussion on July 15, 2025, expressing support for this authority and establishing a violation fee of \$100 for parking in restricted curb zones; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing and approved the first reading of the ordinance on August 19, 2025, with no changes made to the ordinance language; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to formally adopt the ordinance amending Beaumont Municipal Code Chapter 10.06 to reflect this direction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION

The City Council hereby authorizes the City Engineer to evaluate, designate, and paint curb colors for traffic and parking regulation as provided in the ordinance amending Chapter 10.06 of the Beaumont Municipal Code and the fee listed in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.

SECTION 3. REPLACEMENT

The new Parking and Late Payment Penalty Schedule shall rescind, supersede, and replace any previously adopted parking and late payment penalty schedules.

SECTION 4. AUTHORIZATION TO IMPLEMENT

City staff are authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the new Parking and Late Payment Penalty Schedule, including notifying the City's citation processing agency and publishing the penalty amounts on the City's website.

SECTION 5. CERTIFICATION

The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall maintain it in the City's permanent records.
