

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A \$500 ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION FINE FOR UNAUTHORIZED COMMERCIAL TRUCK PARKING AND OPERATION ON NON-DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTES

WHEREAS, the City of Beaumont seeks to ensure public safety, protect local infrastructure, and maintain compliance with designated truck routes as established under Beaumont Municipal Code Title 10; and

WHEREAS, on July 2024, the Beaumont Police Department established the Commercial Enforcement Unit to address truck route and parking violations, issuing over 6,800 citations and generating approximately \$343,000 in fines; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public discussion on October 7, 2025, and directed staff to prepare a public hearing and ordinance establishing new enforcement mechanisms for unauthorized truck activities; and

WHEREAS, to support this ordinance, the City Council desires to formally establish an administrative fine amount for enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, establishing a \$500 fine for unauthorized commercial truck parking and for operating on non-designated truck routes will deter violations, promote compliance, and ensure consistency with the City’s Administrative Citation Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION

The City Council hereby establishes a **\$500 administrative citation fine** for:

- Unauthorized **commercial truck parking** in undesignated locations.
- Unauthorized **operation of commercial trucks** on non-designated truck routes.

Both violations shall be added to the City’s Administrative Citation Schedule and enforced pursuant to the procedures outlined in Beaumont Municipal Code Title 1, Chapter 1.17.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 3. REPLACEMENT

This fine schedule shall supersede and replace any previously adopted fine amounts relating to unauthorized commercial truck parking or truck route violations.

SECTION 4. AUTHORIZATION TO IMPLEMENT

City staff are authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the new Parking and Late Payment Penalty Schedule, including notifying the City’s citation processing agency and publishing the penalty amounts on the City’s website.

SECTION 5. CERTIFICATION

The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall maintain it in the City’s permanent records.
