The City of Beaumont works closely with the Riverside County Fire Department to identify needs when preparing the annual budget. As part of the FY 2026-2027 Fire Department Budget, the City of Beaumont approves the Fire Department staffing levels to change from the current BLS Traditional Staffing level to the ALS Municipal Staffing level so the city is in alignment with the Riverside County Fire Department policy 3.5 for staffing levels.

This correspondence serves as the City's notice and letter of intent to proceed with the staffing changes listed below and to amend the current contract with Riverside County.

- The staffing configuration includes one Fire Captain, one Fire Apparatus Engineer and one Firefighter II, with one person being a paramedic.
